The National Speedskating Championships, both Long Track and Short Track, are skated in classes based upon the competitor's age as of July 1 preceding the competition.
Note: The first year a new class or distance is skated at the National Championships, first place times are listed as "best times," not as national records. The second year these events are skated, the fastest times become national records.

New national records receive final approval at the ASU Convention, held each May and are published in the ASU Handbook.

## Short Track Speedskating

Speedskating is one of the world's oldest winter sports, and it is the sport in which the United States has had the most success in Winter Olympic competition. There are two types of speedskating. Long Track races are skated on a 400 meter track, built specially for speedskating, while short track racing takes place on an 111 meter track laid out on a hockey rink. Since there aren't many 400 meter speedskating tracks in the U.S., most skaters learn to speed skate on the short track. In short track, skaters race against each other in a pack to cross the finish line first, while most long track races are run strictly against the clock. In addition to pure speed, short track features racing strategy, pack skating skills and occasional bumps and spills.

by an exciting team relay event. Speed skates differ from hockey or figure skates mainly in that the blade is long and thin, with no hollow on the bottom. This lets speed skates glide better over the ice, resulting in the ability to reach high speeds. You may have heard about the new "klap-skates" used for the first time in the Nagano Winter Olympics. These skates have a blade that is hinged at the front allowing the skater to continue the power stroke using calf muscles and pushing off the toe without digging the point of the blade into the ice. Klap-skates have resulted in the shattering of almost every long track record, but they are not permitted in short track because of the short straightaways and tight corners and because the skaters are already going too fast!
